

Using iTunes SongSeeker...

Ten Thumbs 4 includes the ability to connect to Apple's iTunes 6 software. You can use Ten Thumbs to control music playback while you're learning to type, and have Ten Thumbs search the Internet for the lyrics of your favorite songs to type along with.

To download and **type lyrics**, follow these easy steps:

1. Start iTunes 6 and play any song you like.
2. Open up Ten Thumbs.
3. Click the on the text in the top right corner of the lesson screen to download the lyrics.

To have Ten Thumbs **choose a playlist** automatically:

1. In *Options* -> *Personal Settings*, select Choose Playlist.
2. You can select any existing play list, or create a "Ten Thumbs" playlist in iTunes.
3. Every time you load your Ten Thumbs file, iTunes will load and start playing the playlist you have selected.

SongSeeker Tips...

- Ten Thumbs can only display lyrics for songs that are available online. Not all songs will be available.
- Check that you typed the name of the song and artist correctly in iTunes. Remove any extraneous punctuation characters.
- Ensure you have a working Internet connection.
- Ensure you have iTunes 6 properly installed, running and playing a song.
- Make sure SongSeeker is enabled in Ten Thumbs. Check the *Personal Settings* in the *Options* screen for the iTunes SongSeeker settings.
- The lyrics will contain most characters of the alphabet, so it is best to do this when you have actually learned the keyboard.
- Pick slower songs until your typing speed improves!
